Thematic workshops

Participants are invited to choose one of the four thematic workshops, which are all related to priorities and activities of the CIB working group and its members, as well as to UCLG Africa's priorities. The thematic workshops should encourage peer-to-peer exchange and learning, as well as joint actions and commitments.

Workshop 1: Gender equality & Inclusive Governance

Co-organizers: FCM, UCLG Africa/Department of Gender and Youth, DeLoG, Province of Barcelona, Metropolis, FSLGA, Region of Catalonia

In 2022, the CIB initiated an effort to build leadership and enable new collaborations within its membership to advance gender equality and social inclusion in decentralized development cooperation. A "Knowledge Hub" partnership was launched at the World Congress, and joint priorities were identified. This workshop will propose an interactive knowledge exchange and brainstorming amongst participants to strive towards gender equality and inclusive governance. The key objective of the workshop will be to facilitate conversation and peer-to-peer exchange, to discuss how we can amplify each other's work, identify common challenges and, ultimately, build collective commitment for action.

The workshop will be kickstarted by a short presentation on the CIB gender knowledge hub. We will then learn about UCLG Africa's African Charter for Local Gender Equality initiative, and the question of creating political commitment for gender equality. This will set the stage for the core of the workshop, which will consist of interactive exchanges between participants to share experiences, challenges and propose commitment on specific aspects of the gender equality and inclusive governance agenda.

Workshop 2: Localizing the SDGs

Co-organizers: UCLG Learning, UCLG Research, UCLG Africa/ALGA and Knowledge Hub, SALGA, VVSG, ANCB

On the 25th of March we were exactly halfway on Agenda 2030, in terms of time. More and more local and regional governments, and their associations, are actively contributing to the achievement of the Sustainable Development Goals. UCLG and partners, including the CIB





working group, try to successfully document on this process, through different processes:

- The development of a yearly report on the progress of LRGs and their associations, which is presented to the UN and member states during the High Level Political Forum on Sustainable Development.
- The facilitation of the development of Voluntary Subnational Reviews (reports produced by Local Government Associations) and Voluntary Local Reviews (report produced by individual local governments/cities), through:
 - i. Coaching sessions by UCLG world secretariat (especially on VSRs)
- ii. Organization of workshops aimed at peer learning (VSRs and VLRs)
- iii. Making available MOOCs and guidelines on both VSRs and VLRs

Documentation of the progress is crucial, for advocacy reasons but also for effectively working on the SDGs, together. How should we organize and improve these processes, in view of scaling up and accelerating towards 2030?

Workshop 3: Disaster preparedness and building resilience Co-organizers: UNDRR, SALAR International, UMT, UCLG Learning, UCLG Africa/ALGA

One of the key objectives of this workshop is to discuss how local authorities can make the transition from humanitarian response centered initiatives to more structural reconstruction activities, after the initial crisis situation. A Video message from UNDRR will recall the DRR challenges and innovations. A highly relevant conversation in the current context of Ukraine, Turkey and Syria, and in many other countries. SALAR International and UCLG will present different existing policy tools, after which there is room for different members which have recently been implementing activities and projects related to resilience, crisis preparedness and response to share their experiences. They are invited to highlight the key challenges they have been dealing with and their lessons learned, for members to create a better overview of what local and regional authorities are doing in terms of recovery work and how this works. Participants of the workshop will then be invited to brainstorm on how we can sustain and maintain this overview, and enhance knowledge sharing and peer learning in this field, through CIB and/or other networks.

Workshop 4: International orientation of Cities

Co-organizers: UCLG Africa/ALGA, City of Barcelona, City of Durban, City of Marrakech, City of Tetouan, City of Tangiers (TBC), UCLG Learning Room N° - Floor

In this workshop, we present the findings from recently conducted CIB research on the role of cities and local authorities in international cooperation for global justice. Based on interviews with Berlin, Amman, Jakarta, Bologna, The Hague, Bruges, Medellin, Malmö, Barcelona and Vienna, the study presents learnings and insights, ranging from the strategic thinking applied to decentralized cooperation, to linking economic development to international cooperation. The workshop aims to discuss the findings, validate them where





	necessary, and to gather additional case studies, insights, as well as next steps, for involved cities and for CIB, after this first study. How do we enhance the knowledge exchange between cities on international cooperation and policies, within the CIB working group?
